Notes:-

Full Member: To become a full member you will have been involved in engineering for at least three years. You will be a technician, draughts-person, designer, supervisor, production engineer or similar. You will be actively involved in Engineering, Science, Technology or a Manufacturing Industry. You also qualify if you are an Employer, Manager or Consultant in any recognised engineering discipline.

Honorary Member: This grade is for those who are not actively engaged in engineering, for instance, retired engineers or just people who have not chosen engineering as a career, but have a strong interest, for example, model engineers.

Student and Associate Member: To qualify for this grade, you will be a Student or Apprentice in any of the disciplines listed above. You will be aged between 18 and 25 years old. From 25 years old you will be expected to take full membership.

Fees: To join the association there is a **nomination fee of £5.00** which should be enclosed with your application form. Your application will be presented to our membership and when you are elected you will be required to pay an annual subscription of **£20.00** for Full and Honorary Members, **£2.00** for Student and Associate Members.
